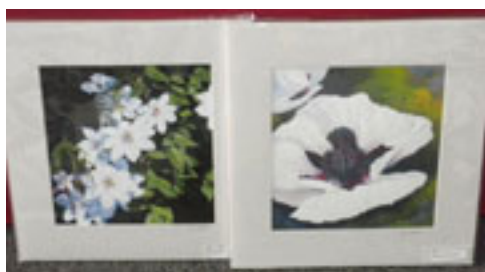




## Greetings from GalleryK!

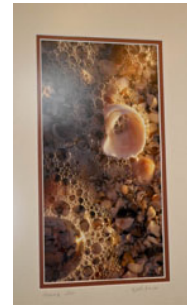

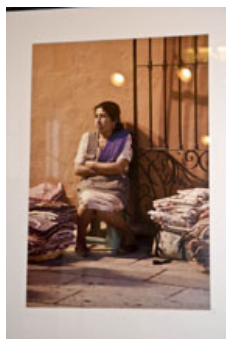

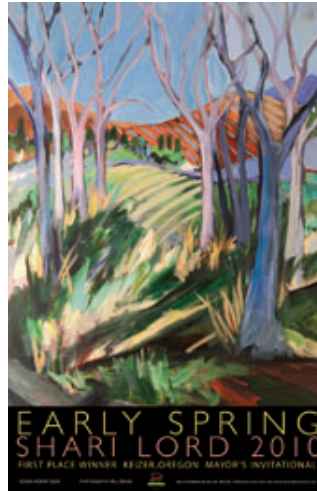
