Directions

From Portland Area: take I-5 South to Exit 260B, turn right at end of exit. After crossing RR tracks, move to far left lane and turn left onto Chemawa Rd. Go 1.1 miles. The KAA building and parking lot are on your left.

From Eugene Area: take I-5 North, take Exit 260 toward Keizer and turn left onto Chemawa Rd. After you cross back over I-5 and cross the RR tracks, move to far left lane and turn left to stay on Chemawa Rd. Go 1.1 miles. The KAA building and parking lot are on your left.

Artists Reception and Awards Ceremony

A reception and awards ceremony will be held on **Saturday, March 30, from 2–4 p.m.** Light refreshments will be served. We will also hold our annual raffle in the classroom, with tickets \$1 ea. or 6 for \$5.

All events are on the second floor. A "lift" for those unable to climb stairs is available at the rear building entry.

Entry Requirements and Instructions

- All entries will be accepted, subject to restrictions below or show capacity being reached.
- Open to living artists 18 years of age or older.
- Concept, design, and execution of artwork must be **solely** that of the individual artist entering it. Original work only. No prints allowed.
- Colored pencil must constitute 60% or more of the work.
- Artwork must be no more than three years old and not previously exhibited at an annual DC 201 show.
- You may enter two paintings, and one must be for sale. If you enter only one painting, it must be for sale (*this is a gallery requirement, not a requirement of DC 201*). Maximum **framed** size: 32" x 40".
- Frame must be **ready to hang** with **D-rings and wire ONLY**.
- Frames should be simple in design, with **white, off-white, beige, gray or black mats** only. Glazing may be acrylic or glass.
- All artwork must remain in place throughout the show.
- Keizer Art Association will retain a 40% commission on all sales.
- Art must be delivered and picked up at KAA according to the schedule. DC 201 designated drivers will be available in some areas.
- Show managers reserve the right to eliminate an entry if they determine the art does not meet requirements.
- Entry constitutes agreement with all terms of this prospectus.

Packaging and Delivery

1. Be sure to affix a label (below) to the back(s) of your work.
2. If a DC 201 designated driver is transporting your work**, please make a "bag." Create a **loose-fitting** protective bag from bubble wrap, foam, or any cushioned product for your framed art that can be easily reused. **It must fit LOOSELY so that your frame can slide easily in and out.**
3. Put your name and the title of your artwork in **LARGE print** that is **clearly visible** on the **OUTSIDE of your bag**, so we can easily match it up to your art when the show ends.
4. If you are delivering your own artwork to Keizer and picking it up when the show closes, package it as you wish, unwrap it at the show, take your packaging home with you, and bring it back on pickup day. **Note:** If there is any chance you will want someone else to pick up your artwork, you should make a bag as directed above, and advise and leave your packaging with the show manager at the show.

Designated Drivers

If you are planning to transport your own artwork and are willing to be a designated driver (you must commit to both drop-off and pick-up dates), please contact Ellen White (ellen@kittycentral.us or 503-423-7415). Sorry, DC 201 does not reimburse drivers for gas or mileage.

****NOTE:** All reasonable care will be taken with transported artwork; however, designated drivers are not liable for accidental damage. If you ask a designated driver to transport your work, please offer to contribute toward gas expenses, if you can.
