



February, 2021 - “Winter Showcase” & “McNary High School Art Show”

The February show is a combined art show for the art students at McNary High School and for all KAA members or others who may wish to enter. We expect a lower number of McNary entries than have been entered in the past due to virtual learning. All media and any subject may be entered into this February show.

INTAKE is Wednesday, January 6th to Wednesday, February 2nd.

There will be no reception. However, Friday, February 5th, the show will be judged and notification of awards will be sent out to winners and KAA members by February 6th.

This show runs from February 5th to February 24th.

THE FOLLOWING ARE GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ALL KAA SHOWS:

Art Media

- 2D - Two dimensional pieces, such as: watercolor, oil, acrylic, mixed media, colored pencil or fabric art.
- Photography – Any image created within the confines of a camera and using camera related adjustments in post processing for lighting, contrast, color, sharpness, cropping, etc.
- Digital Art – Photos edited and changed using artistic filter adjustments in post processing, photo painting, digital collages, integrated art, digital painting or any other artistic rendition using a computer and software.
- 3D – Pieces show width, height and depth, such as: carving, modeling, or welding materials into a work of art (for example, a sculpture).
- Youth Art – Any of the above media entered by children 4 – 14 years of age.
- McNary High School Show

Entry Mandates

McNary art entries will be submitted by the McNary High School teacher with name of student and name of art only. Individual entry forms are not required for students.

- All work must be original.
- All media are acceptable and the show is open to all artists.
- Edges of unframed wall art must be suitably finished (no visible staples/jagged edges).
- Jewelry and other small objects should be displayed in a secure, professional manner.
- Artwork exhibited in this gallery within the past two years is not acceptable.
- Up to four entries per artist are permitted.
- **Entries must be listed on the online Entry Form.** Submission of the online entry form represents your signature and signifies your agreement of the terms as shown on the form. Award winners of this show should be ready, if they desire, to show, for the month of March, their art at the Keizer Civic Center complete with frames, mats and glass. Winners of awards will be contacted by Terry Dempsey, KAA board member, regarding participation in the show at the Keizer Civic Center.

Awards

This exhibit is juried and awards will be announced for best of show and for juror's merit award; for first, second and third place in each of these media categories: 2-D art, photography, digital art, 3D art and youth art. \$20 will be awarded to the first place winner in each media category with at least three entries. The decision of the judge(s) is final. A \$100 award will be given to the artist of the best of show.

Entry Fees

The entry fee for our 2021 virtual show is \$5 for each of one to four entries (\$5 to \$20). There will be no charge for the McNary High School entries.

Sale of Art

- Commission fee for sales is 60% to the artist and 40% to KAA.
