



#### **KAA FREE OPEN STUDIOS**


Fridays, 1 – 5 pm, Any Medium.

## **CALL TO ARTISTS**

The Keizer Art Association, in partnership with the Keizer Area Chamber of Commerce, invites you to participate in the first annual Riverwalk Art Fair.

This event coincides with the long-standing KeizerFest in the lovely Keizer Rapids Park. Artist vendor spaces will be along the shaded and paved walk by the Willamette River, which is a short walk from what will be the hustle and bustle of KeizerFest..

The fair is on August 9, 10 and 11, 2024, Set up is on August 8, 2024 – 3 to 7 pm. Hours on Friday and Saturday are from 10 am to 6 pm and Sunday hours are from 10 am to 3 pm. Load out on Sunday begins at 3 pm. Artist's booths must be occupied during the full hours stated above. There will be no early takedown.

This art fair will be open to all Oregon resident artists with their own original artwork and reproductions. Multiple artists may share space upon approval.

A 10 x 10 booth space will be available in the grass and along a paved pathway. Booths must have four-sided walls and must have straight weighted legs. Booth fees are \$150, any cancellations must be made by June  $8^{th}$  (\$25 entry fee will be non-refundable). Four-sided tent rental available for \$225 additional.

There will be 24-hour security provided. NO commission on sales!



## EXPLORING SCRATCHBOARD ART

Instructor: Laura Singer
Saturday, June 22nd, 10 am – 2:00 pm
Experience Level: All
Cost: \$25 + \$30 Materials kit paid directly to instructor

Learn all about and try your hand at scratchboard in this one-day workshop. Scratchboard is a smooth, white clay board in a layer of black India ink. You draw by scratching or scraping away the ink to reveal the white underneath. It's like drawing, but in reverse. Add color with fast-drying, inks if you wish, then scratch again to reveal highlights. It's easy, an it's very fun!

# **CANCELLED** THIS CLASS WILL BE RESCHEDULED

This workshop will cover how to select or prep your own scratchboard surface, what materials are handy to have and where to get them, different techniques for scratching, how to add color with ink, and how to seal your final scratchboard to protect it. All materials are provided by the instructor and are yours to keep, including helpful handouts, a small scratchboard for practice, tools for sketching and scratching, a paintbrush for repairing mistakes, a brush for removing crumbs, and one archival 8 x 8 inch scratchboard for finished piece. Instructor will have subject reference photos available to choose from, or bring your own inspiration (about 8 x 8 inches). No previous drawing experience is necessary.

We will break for a half hour, around noon, so bring your lunch.


