



Learn how to mix delicate, neutralized shadows and a variety of earthy greens on a step-by-step rose painting. Plus learn how to create the wonderful glow of sunlight with value contrast, glazing, and soft or hard edges.

All levels of painting experience are welcome!
The rose drawing will be sent to you to transfer onto your
140# Arches cold-pressed watercolor paper (cut to an 8 1/2"
x 11" size) BEFORE coming to the Workshop. Please
