

# KEIZER ART ASSOCIATION PRESENTS COLORED PENCIL CLASSES



Colored Pencil Classes are taught by various talented artists. Realism, abstraction, whimsy, landscape, portraiture, and wildlife are all favorite subjects of colored pencil students. In these classes you will learn color theory, layering, strokes, use of paper and tools, dry pencil, watercolor pencil and much more. These classes show the student how much fun it is to learn new techniques and stretch your expertise. All levels of pencil pushers welcome. Please sign up for class at least two weeks ahead of time. We are limited to 18 students.



This workshop is comprised of four consecutive Tuesday sessions. We will be reviewing portrait painting composition and techniques. You will gain experience in mixing paint to match various skin tones. Students may provide their own reference photo following the guidelines noted below, or use the provided reference photo pictured on the right. An 11x14 panel will be provided for your painting.

Although formal classroom instruction is scheduled from 2PM – 4PM, the classroom will remain open for extended instruction and painting time at your discretion (until 5:30 for the first two classes and until 6:30 for the remaining two classes).

Students with limited painting experience or experience in mediums other than oil paint are welcome. We will be painting in a safe and healthy manner, minimizing the use of toxic solvents. Basic equipment and materials are provided for in-class work with the exception of paper towels and an apron (if desired) however you are encouraged to bring your own tabletop easel and supplies if you have them.




Please bring the following supplies:

With a limited palette of three watercolors: Ultramarine Blue, Winsor Red (or Cadmium Red), and Daniel Smith New Gamboge, learn how to mix rich browns, earthy greens, and muted oranges to paint this fall squash. Learn how to mix a creamy tint for the base color on the squash and then paint the beautiful squash pattern with glazing techniques. All levels of painting experience are welcome!

The squash drawing will be sent to you to transfer onto your 140# Arches cold-pressed watercolor paper (cut to an 8 1/2" x 11" size) BEFORE coming to the Workshop. #### Hawaiian Honeycreeper

Mosaic Effect with Acrylics Instructor: Laura Singer

When: Saturday, November 8, 2025, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

In this one-day workshop we will create a fun mosaic effect using crackle paste and high flow acrylic paint. The class will cover what materials are needed, how to prep the panel with the crackle paste, how to add color with liquid acrylic paints to achieve a watercolor-like look, and how to seal the finished painting to protect it. Our subject will be an amakihi, which is a species of honeycreeper (bird) found on the Hawaiian Islands. No drawing experience is needed, since we will transfer the design to the panel using a tracing technique. We'll break for a half hour around noon, so bring your lunch. Refrigerator and microwave available.

Well, hello! I'm Richard Wade. You may have seen me paint before using oil paints on my show, on Salem's public access television, called The Salem Painter. I have been working on adapting those techniques to work with acrylic paints to make them more accessible to people and I look forward to sharing that with you. The fun thing about painting is that once you know a few simple techniques, you can paint anything you can imagine. The hardest part is getting started with that big, blank canvas in front of you. That's where I come in. I will guide you through the painting step by step, however I look forward to seeing the personal touches you add to your painting! In this class we will learn about mixing colors to get the tones we want and how to work in layers to paint elements of the painting one at a time. Everyone can do this and I invite you to paint along, whether you have been painting for years or this is your first time trying.


