



## **MARCH KAA COLOR SHOW “BLUE”**

This show is always well-received. Art must show some of the color BLUE. The amount of blue is up to the artist. You may choose for the blue to be predominate, somewhat visible, or somewhere in the middle. Art of any medium may be entered. Children ages 4 to 14 are encouraged to enter this show.

**INTAKE** will be on Wednesday, February 28<sup>th</sup>, from 3 to 6 pm in the KAA gallery.

**RECEPTION** will be on Saturday, March 2<sup>nd</sup>, from 2 to 4 pm. Awards will be presented at that time.

Plan now to participate in this show. Some wonderful artwork will be shown. The public, artists, family and friends are invited to attend. Artists who are exhibiting works are encouraged to attend as the public enjoys visiting with you.

This show will run from February 29<sup>th</sup> through April 2<sup>nd</sup>.

## **THE FOLLOWING ARE GUIDELINES FOR ALL KAA SHOWS**

The Keizer Art Association reserves the right to determine if art submitted meets the family friendly standards as determined by the Board of Directors. The Board also reserves the right to jury submitted art for size, as space limitations mandate. Please refer to guidelines below for further details.

### **Art Media**

- **2D** – Two-dimensional pieces, such as: watercolor, oil, mixed-media, colored pencil, or fabric art. Art larger than 48” x 48” will not be accepted into the show.
- **Photography** – Any image created within the confines of a camera and using camera related adjustments in post processing for lighting, contrast, color, sharpness, cropping, etc. Art larger than 48” x 48” will not be accepted into the show.
- **Digital Art** – Photos edited and changed using artistic filter adjustments in post processing, photo painting, digital collages, integrated art, digital painting or any other artistic rendition using a computer and software. Art larger than 48” x 48” will not be accepted into the show.
- **3D** – Three-dimensional media occupies space defined through the dimensions of height, width and depth. Art larger than 48” x 48” will not be accepted into the show.
- **Youth Art** – Any of the above media entered by children 4 – 14 years of age.

### **Entry Mandates**

- All work must be original to the artist.
- All media are acceptable.
- Jewelry and other small objects should be photographed for entry in a professional manner.
- Artwork exhibited in this gallery within the past two years is not acceptable, even with color or digital alterations.
- Up to four entries per artist are permitted.

- **Wall art must have sturdy hangers.** Acceptable hangers must be compatible with our hanging system. **Sawtooth hangers are not acceptable.** When there is a question regarding the appropriateness of the hanger, one of the board members at intake will attempt to hang the art. The board member's decision to accept or reject the hanger will be final.
- **Please list your entries on the online Entry Form.** Submission of the online entry form represents your signature and signifies your agreement of the terms as shown on the form. If you are unable to use the online entry form, you may fill one out at intake in the gallery. If you are unable to pay online, you may pay at intake in the gallery.
- **Civic Center Show.** Award winners of this show should be ready, if they desire, to show their art for the month of April at the Keizer Civic Center complete with frames, mats and glass. The winning art will be moved over to the Civic Center Show by Terry Dempsey, KAA board member. ### **Awards**

This exhibit is judged and awards will be announced for best of show, juror's merit award and for first, second and third place in each media category. Awards include \$100 to the artist of the best of show.

### **Entry Fees**

- **Members:** \$10 for the first piece; \$15 for two pieces; \$15 for diptychs and triptychs (a single work of art displayed on two or three panels); \$20 for three pieces; \$25 for four pieces.
- **Non-Members:** \$20 for the first piece; \$25 for two pieces; \$25 for diptychs and triptychs (a single work of art displayed on two or three panels); \$30 for three pieces; \$35 for four pieces.
- **Youth Art:** \$5 for up to two pieces. This division is open to youth 4 – 14 years of age.

### **Sale of Art**

- Commission fee for sales is 70% to artist and 30% to KAA.

### **Important Dates**

- Intake is on Wednesday, February 28<sup>th</sup>, from 3 to 6 pm in the KAA gallery.
- Pick-up art is April 3rd from 3 to 6 in the classroom. **Art entered in KAA shows must be picked up on the pick-up date stated in this prospectus, unless you have previously made arrangements to pick up your art within a week. KAA insurance lapses on pick-up date. Artwork not picked up within 30 days of pick-up date, will become the property of KAA.**

**A signed entry form and fees must accompany your entry.** Entry forms are available on the KAA website. You may type in your information right on the online form. You may pay your fee on the site. If you cannot complete an entry form online, you may finish one at intake in the gallery. If you cannot pay online, you may pay in the gallery at intake.
